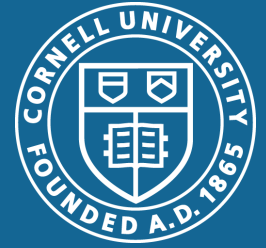

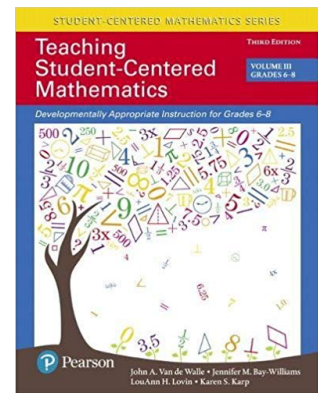
Infusing Mathematical Practices into Tasks to Support and Challenge Every Student
